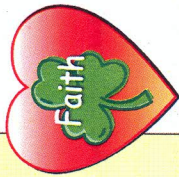


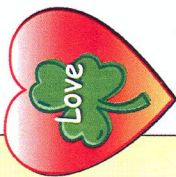
# St Patrick's Core Values

### The School will:

- Support the family in the child's Religious Education
- Provide a good quality education with a range of learning opportunities and extra curricular activities designed to enrich children's experiences whilst encouraging children to do their best at all times
- Maintain a safe and attractive learning environment, providing good resources and equipment
- Set appropriate homework and ensure that feedback is given
- Make sure that all children understand The Core Values of St Patrick's Catholic School
- Make sure that staff set high standards of personal behaviour and are always courteous, polite and professional at all times
- Teach children to develop positive attitudes regardless of gender, race, culture, value, age and need
- Ensure that children are safe on the school premises and on school trips
- Listen sympathetically and provide help and support to all children
- Give clear information about the curriculum and each child's progress, standard achieved and development needs
- Communicate frequently with parents about school matters and set dates for events as early as possible

### Parents will:

- Make sure their child arrives at school on time for Prayers and Registration at 8.50a.m. every morning
- Support the school's Christian Ethos and Core Values
- Inform the school of any issues that may affect the safeguarding of children
- Make sure their child attends school regularly
- Make sure holidays are not taken during term time
- Contact the school on the morning of any child's absence and provide a note of explanation when child returns to school
- Provide the correct school uniform and P.E. kit in accordance with the School Uniform Policy and ensuring that PE kits and outdoor learning kits are in school every day
- Attend Open Evenings/Teacher and Learner Conferences (TLCs) with your child to discuss child's progress once a term.
- Support all the School's Policies and Guidelines for Behaviour
- Make sure that the school always has an up to date emergency contact numbers
- Encourage their child to care for school property both at school and at home
- Be courteous and polite in all dealings with school staff
- Read and act upon any information sent home
- Raise any concerns with the appropriate person as early as possible
- Work in partnership with the school to develop positive attitudes towards others
- Support the child in homework.
- Agree not to publish school photographs or school videos on the Internet or any Social Networking sites i.e. YouTube or Face book.
- Agree not to discuss school incidents or individual families, children or staff on Social Networking Sites. Any concerns must be discussed directly with the School
